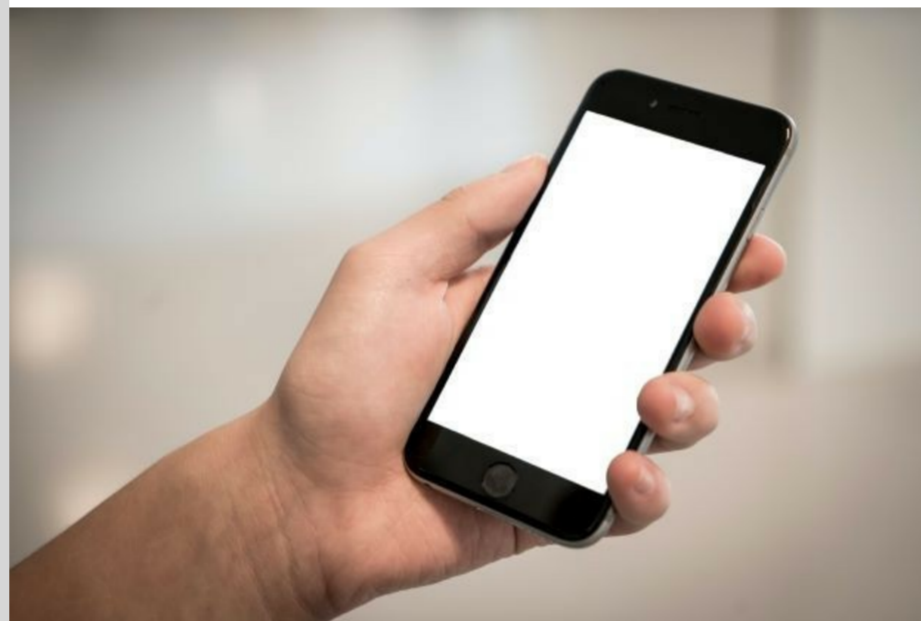




As we head into the holiday season, here are our top six business tips for ending 2022 on a positive note.
